- Improvements to residential properties must be 100% complete prior to filing a CRA application.
- If the project is deemed eligible by the Housing Officer, he will sign the application and certify it to the County Auditor's Office.
- A CRA residential abatement becomes effective the calendar year following the year in which it is certified to the Auditor's Office.

  Therefore, if these steps do not take place by December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year in which property improvements are made, taxes may be due on the improvements for a year before the abatement becomes effective, however a full 5 years of abatement will be given.
- Any improvements that are partially or fully completed by

  January 1 of any year are eligible to be taxed. This is considered
  to be the tax lien year. Taxes follow a year behind the tax lien
  year.
